## The Proposed IPRAC Bill and PRAC Policy

We expect the bill to be submitted to Parliament for legislation later in the year.

## Accreditation of PR Professionals

We will be launching the accreditation programme for PR professionals by mid this year with the Working Group on Certification expected to finalise development of the curriculum by end of February and, thereafter engage stakeholders on the content and structure of the programme. ## The 2020 Training Calendar

The 2020 training calendar presents new and exciting value addition programmes. From masterclasses to full day and whole week courses. We will share this mid this month to enable you plan yourselves accordingly.

We have also revised the annual mandatory Continuous Professional Development (CPD) points from **60** to **40** points. Please note that this will be operational beginning this year and will be a prerequisite to membership renewal in 2021.
