## DEFERMENT OF PRSK MARCH AND APRIL PROGRAMMES

The Public Relations Society of Kenya (PRSK) Council has deferred **all** programmes and workshops that were slated for March and April to later dates.

These include:

- Leadership & Change Management Workshop tentatively moved to April 20-24, 2020
- 2. News Writing Bootcamp
- 3. IPRAC Bill and PRAC Policy Validation Workshop
- 4. Storytelling for Public Relations Masterclass
- 5. Enhancing Corporate Communication for Effective Corporate Governance tentatively moved to **May 4-8, 2020**

This has been occasioned by the confirmation of the novel Corona virus in Kenya and in compliance with HE President Uhuru Kenyatta's directive issued on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

As the relevant Government departments work to contain the virus, I call on all Public Relations practitioners to help in spreading relevant information on the virus from trusted sources, i.e. Ministry of Health and World Health Organization (WHO).

As a precautionary measure, I ask that you ensure you observe the following guidelines from the Ministry of Health:

- 1. Wash hands regularly with soap and water; or use alcohol-based sanitiser
- 2. Cough or sneeze into disposable tissues or flexed elbow; and wash hands immediately after
- 3. Observe 2 metres social distance from people who have flu-like symptoms
- 4. Avoid handshake, hugging and kissing with people with flu-like symptoms.
