
Let the Celebrations Begin!

- 1** Facilitate implementation of the IPRAC Bill and roll out of the Certification programme.
- 2** Purchase PRSK Office space – The office space will provide a space for members to meet, collaborate and share. It will be fitted with physical plug and play work stations for our members and networking spaces for members, fellows and retired members. It will also host a Virtual Resource Centre.
- 3** To establish a PRSK Education Revolving Fund - The revolving fund will provide loans and scholarships for our members who wish to join the Certification Programme.
- 4** Research, publications and mentorship: Facilitate the establishment of a research centre that will serve as the home of industry trends and roll out the PRSK Student Internship and Mentorship Programme.
- 5** Facilitate investment in technology to enhance service delivery to members – This will help the society to purchase an integrated membership management system, launch a PRSK Application and revamp the website to make it more interactive.
