THE CERTIFIED PUBLIC RELATIONS PROFESSIONAL (CPRP) QUALIFICATION

The CPRP qualification is offered by the Public Relations Society of Kenya (PRSK) through a partnership with KASNEB. Under the partnership documented through a Memorandum of Understanding, PRSK develops the syllabus and the CPRP examination whereas KASNEB makes arrangements for the administration, marking and processing of the examination results.

The CPRP examination is structured in three modules with a total of twenty papers.

INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR EXAMINERS (SETTERS AND MARKERS)

As part of the roll out of the CPRP syllabus, PRSK and KASNEB wish to recruit a dedicated team of setters and markers to develop and mark the CPRP examination. In this connection, qualified and competent persons are invited to apply for consideration as markers and setters for the CPRP examination.

Markers and setters are invited to apply for at least one and a maximum of three papers, listed in order of preference and competence, based on the above structure of the CPRP examination, provided they meet the minimum requirements as specified in the advertisement.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants will be required to meet the following minimum requirements:

- a) Academic and professional qualifications
 - i) Bachelors Degree in a relevant subject area
 - ii) Masters Degree in a relevant subject area
 - iii) Professional qualification in the subject area of interest
- b) Work experience
 - i) At least three (3) years relevant experience in teaching, research, and professional practice or other relevant engagement
 - ii) Evidence of work as a contracted examination professional in examination bodies will be an added advantage
 - iii) Successful applicants must be in possession of post-qualification teaching experience of not less than five (5) years in a recognised university or possession of at least three (3) years' experience in practice with not less than two (2) years teaching experience at university or tertiary level.
- c) Other requirements that successful applicants will be required to demonstrate include:
 - i) Compliance with Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya 2010
 - ii) Ability to work within strict timelines as the Society shall specify

PERSONAL ATTRIBUTES

The ideal candidates should be persons of high moral uprightness and unquestionable integrity. They should espouse the virtues of honesty, hard work, diligence and professional fidelity

The selected markers and setters will be allocated responsibilities from time to time in setting and marking various professional examination papers.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

- i) Examiners should apply for not more than two (2) subject areas in order of priority and expertise
- ii) The areas selected should be ideally in the same subject cluster
- iii) The application should be in soft copy (PDF format) and not more that four pages
- iv) Other guidelines are as per the advertisement

Interested candidates who meet the above minimum requirements are required to send their application letters accompanied by detailed curriculum vitae, copies of academic and professional certificates, testimonials and national identity (ID) cards and names and addresses of three (3) referees to the undersigned on or before the close of business on 7th October 2021.
